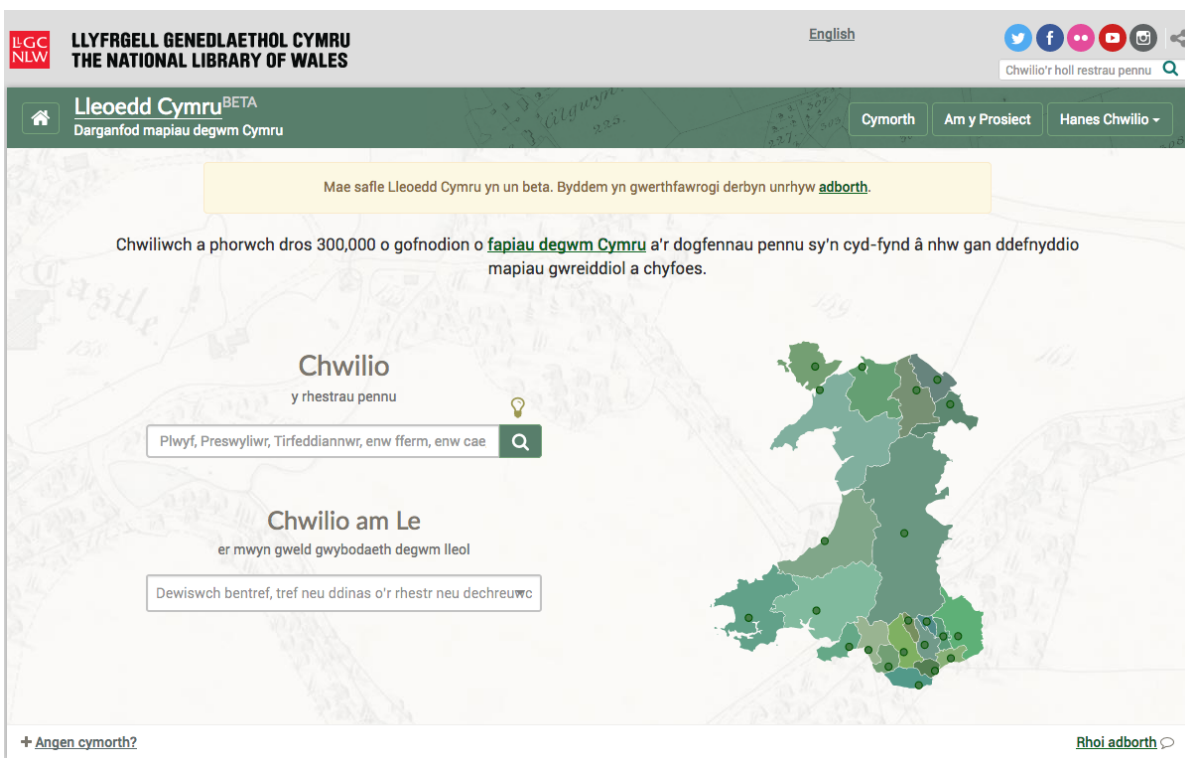


Digital learning resources
